("Enrico Fermi") is proud to announce our 62nd year of providing College scholarships for High School Seniors with traceable Italian heritage who are residents of either Yonkers or Westchester County, NY. Starting as a small community-based organization in Yonkers as a dream of our founder, Mike Vitulli, we have sustained our ability to provide scholarships to worthy recipients with exceptional academics and inspirational commitment to the community.

We are thrilled to share that we have increased our scholarship offerings to a total of nine to now include an additional Yonkers and County-wide scholarship. So, now we will be awarding five scholarships to Yonkers residents (from four), and three in the County (from two). This is in addition to our Fermi Countywide Science Scholarship. We have increased the total dollars to be awarded to \$50,000! Scholarship applications are online on our website at www.enricofermi.org. Eligibility criteria and timetable is also included.
